










# Crystal Bracelet



<p>An exclusive kit from The Bead Shed <a href="http://www.thebeadshed.co.uk">www.thebeadshed.co.uk</a> Difficulty Level ① ② ③ ④ ⑤</p>	<p>You will need....</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ½ meter Tigertail beading wire</li> <li>• 8-10 8mm Crystal Bicone Beads</li> <li>• 14-18 6mm Faceted Beads</li> <li>• 100 ish Sz 11 Seed Beads</li> <li>• 20 Crimp Beads</li> <li>• Clasp &amp; Extender Chain</li> </ul>
	<p><b>1.</b> Bend the Tigertail in half and string it through the end of the extender chain.</p>	 <p><b>2.</b> Thread a Crimp Bead onto both strands and using Crimping Pliers or Flat Nose Pliers, squash the crimp bead close to the chain.</p>
	<p><b>3.</b> String on an 8mm Bicone Bead and Crimp again right after it to hold it in place.</p>	 <p><b>4.</b> Separate the strands of Tigertail and onto each one thread:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3 Sz 11 Seed Beads</li> <li>• 1 6mm Faceted Bead</li> <li>• 3 Sz 11 Seed Beads</li> </ul> <p>Then thread both strands through a crimp bead, pushing it up tight to the beads and crimp close.</p>
	<p><b>5.</b> Repeat Steps 3 and 4 until your bracelet is long enough to go around your wrist, make sure it is not too long as the extender chain can be used to lengthen if necessary. <b>DO NOT CRIMP THE LAST CRIMP BEAD ...</b></p>	 <p><b>6.</b> Thread both wires through the clasp and back through the un-crimped crimp bead, and if possible the next few beads too.</p>
	<p><b>7.</b> Pull the wire in tight and crimp the crimp bead tight to secure. Trim off the excess wire.</p>	 <p><b>8.</b> Congratulations, you have just finished your Crystal Bracelet.</p>
