



Bugle Ring

You will need:

- 1 meter Monofilament
- Approx 3g (30-50) x 6mm Bugle Beads
- 5 Feature Beads (5-8mm)
- 5 Matching sz 11 Seed Beads



1. Take a meter of Monofilament and string a bugle bead in the centre.
2. Add another bugle bead by threading into it from both sides so it forms a ladder effect.



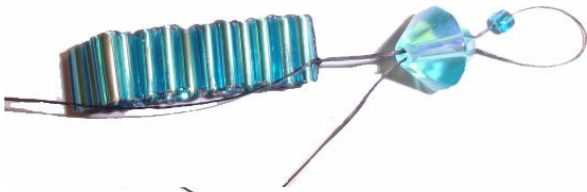
3. Continue Step 2 until your strip is long enough to fit your desired finger.



4. Pull your monofilament through the first bead in the same manner as when you add a bead, this will pull the work together into a ring.



5. Tie the monofilament in a knot on top of the work, do a couple of knots on top to secure,



6. String on a feature bead, followed by a seed beads, then missing out the seed bead, thread back through the feature bead and pull in tight.



7. Knot the two threads together to secure, do a couple of knots to make sure it is nice and tight.



8. Repeat Step 6 until you have a cluster of 5 beads.
9. Double knot your thread and trim off.
