

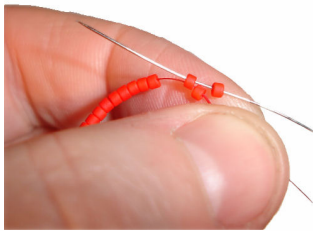


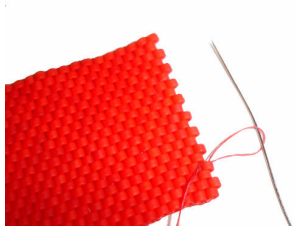
Napkin Ring

You will need:

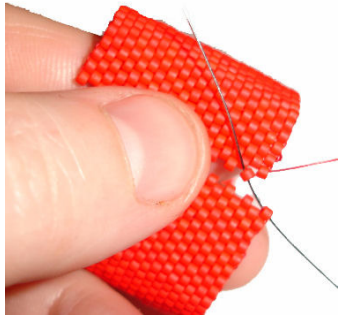
7.5g Delica Beads
Beading Thread & Needle
2 Acrylic Leaves
1 Acrylic Flower
1 5mm Crystal Bead

1. Thread a needle with a meter of Beading Thread.
2. Anchor a Delica bead onto the end of your thread by sewing through it three or four times. (You will cut this off later)
3. String on 20 Delica Beads (You can do it wider if you like but you need to have an even number)
4. Leaving an approx 15cm tail, add another Delica bead to your needle and missing the last bead on your thread sew back through the second last one.
5. Pick up another Delica bead and again miss a bead and sew through the next one.
6. Repeat Step 5, to the end of the row. This will form a row of 'turrets'.
7. Turn your work around and work back in the same way, picking up a bead and sewing into each 'turret' to the end.
8. Repeat these rows until your work measures approx 12cm long. At this point you need to fold your strip of beading into a ring to see if the edges will 'zip' together, if the ends do not fit into each other do one more row.





9. If you need to add more thread along the way, then simply weave your end through a few rows, adding a half-hitch knot along the way to secure. Add a new thread in the same way.



10. Fold the beaded strip into a ring and 'zip up' the edges by sewing into a bead from one edge and then the other. Pull tight and weave back through to strengthen.



11. Weave your thread through to the centre of the piece and sew on a leaf, followed by a second leaf 10mm apart.



12. Inbetween the two leaves , add a flower, then a crystal, followed by a Delica bead, then sew back through them all and weave your thread in to secure.



13. Roll up your Napkin and add your Napkin ring.
