<p>An exclusive kit from The Bead Shed <a href="http://www.thebeadshed.co.uk">www.thebeadshed.co.uk</a> Difficulty Level ① ② ③ ④ ⑤</p>	<p>You will need....</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 32 x 6mm Stardust metal beads</li> <li>• 32 Headpins</li> <li>• 2 Earring Wires</li> <li>• 2 Extender Chains, or 16 link lengths of chain</li> <li>• 32 Seed Beads</li> </ul>	
	<p><b>1.</b> Take a head pin and thread on a seed bead and a Stardust Bead.</p>		<p><b>2.</b> With Round Nose Pliers, bend the pin over into a loop close to the bead, but do not cut off.</p>
	<p><b>3.</b> Thread the pin through the last loop on your extender chain.</p>		<p><b>4.</b> Holding your loop tight with your pliers, wind the pin around the bottom of the loop twice to wrap onto the top of the bead.</p>
	<p><b>5.</b> Cut off the excess wire as close as possible to the bead.</p>		<p><b>6.</b> Tuck the wire edge in neat to the bead so you do not have any sharp ends.</p>
	<p><b>7.</b> Repeat STEP 1-6, but this time adding the wire to the second link on the chain.</p>		<p><b>8.</b> Continue until you have one bead added to every link in the chain.</p>
	<p><b>9.</b> Open the hook on an Earwire and add the top link of the chain to the loop before closing securely.</p>		<p><b>10.</b> Make a second one exactly the same way.</p> <p>© S Simmons, The Bead Shed, 2008</p>
